Alex Ferrer, 46, never thought he'd be on TV. He became one of Florida's youngest police officers when he joined the force at 19, then earned his law degree before becoming a circuit court judge at 34. When he stepped down from that bench to host his courtroom show, Judge Alex, he went from presiding over murder cases to arbitrating disputes over things like a mysteriously impregnated dog.
